Hickory Street Update

May 9, 2018

As you are starting to see, work is beginning on the Hickory Street Redevelopment Project. While the goal is to create a safer environment for all, of particular interest is the span of Hickory Street between Hibiscus Boulevard and NASA Boulevard. This stretch will be made much safer, especially for the many physicians, associates, patients and visitors who park in the lots on the east side of Hickory Street and cross by foot to get to the hospital and other medical facilities located on the west side.

We anticipate the first road closure to occur at Oak Street on May 22. You will see increased activity here as early as next week. Exact traffic patterns are being finalized. We will share this and all other updates with you as soon as they become available. The City of Melbourne will also place detailed signage to indicate any detour patterns.

Additionally, there are trees along Hickory Street near the A parking lot that have been marked for removal next week. The row of parking closest to these trees will be blocked for approximately one day while this work is being completed.

We anticipate the Hickory Street project to span the next nine months, so please keep watch for updates as construction progresses.
